**CURBING THE MENACE OF
RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS**

WHAT IS RAGGING :

As per University Grants Commission notification Ragging means :

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

OBJECTIVES :

To root out ragging in all its forms from college by prohibiting it by law, preventing its occurrence by following the provisions of the Regulation framed by the UGC and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and the appropriate law in force.

PUNISHABLE INGREDIENTS OF RAGGING :

- Abetment to Ragging;
- Criminal conspiracy to rag;
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging;
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- Wrongful restrain;
- Wrongful confinement;
- Use of criminal force;
- Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences;
- Extortion;
- Criminal trespass;
- Offences against property;
- Criminal intimidation;
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mention offences against the victim(s);
- Physical or psychological humiliation;

- All other offences following from the definition of “Ragging”.
- Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of bffi, place of residence or ecorpmic background.
